**1. Answer Challenge questions** • Answer all Challenge questions from Seven Ancient Wonders — page 33 of the *Atlas of Discovery*. **Three points**

**3. Build a pyramid** • Download the Build a Pyramid worksheet ([www.jaconline.com.au/atlasofdiscovery/links/learningcentres.html](http://www.jaconline.com.au/atlasofdiscovery/links/learningcentres.html)) and follow the instructions to construct a scale model of a pyramid. **Four points**



**4. Trace a word root** • A mausoleum is a large tomb. Find out which king the word was named after and provide details about his tomb (including a picture) and its importance as one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World (see page 132 of the *Atlas of Discovery*). **Four points**



**5. Design an ancient wonder** • The Seven Wonders of the Ancient World were once the most advanced examples of human technology and achievement. Research information about one ancient society and design your own ancient wonder to represent something that was important to the society you have chosen. You could draw your ancient wonder using labels to show the important features and links to the society. You may instead like to make a sculpture or build a model of your ancient wonder and provide written support to justify your construction. **Seven points**



**6. Make a PowerPoint presentation** • Prepare a PowerPoint demonstration to describe each of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Provide information about when they were built, why they were built, how they were constructed and how they were destroyed. Grade the Seven Wonders from most impressive to least impressive. Make your presentation a countdown to show them in order, with the last Wonder shown representing the one you think is the most impressive. Provide one example of an ancient building that you think should have been picked and state why. **Seven points**



**7. Prepare a group project** • In a small group prepare a list of the seven wonders of your local area. They may be well-known locations, monuments, buildings and parks, or they could be places that are special to the group members. Each group member must then prepare a page of information about at least one of the seven wonders for inclusion in the group project. Be sure to include a diagram or photograph of the site, information about the site and reasons why it was selected. **Seven points**



**8.
