

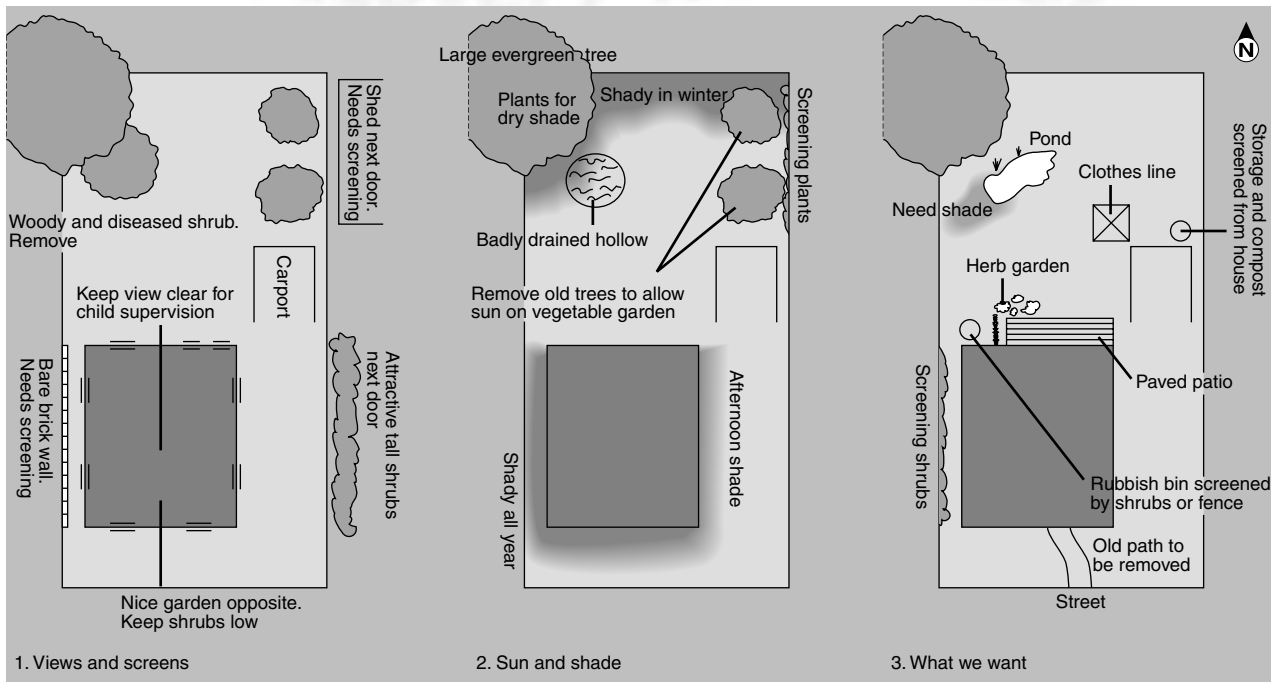


Discovery Worksheets
